How do you plan to balance your personal and professional life to meet the demands of this position? Clinical directors often manage many responsibilities, depending on the size of the clinic and the number of employees they manage. If you're applying to work at larger clinic, you may have more team members to oversee. Interviewers may seek to learn whether you can complete the necessary work for this position while also caring for your self and enjoying your role as a clinic director. Example: "As a clinical director of an orthopedic office, I often received work calls late in the evening causing me to miss social engagements. To promote work-life balance, I set boundaries and rearranged my schedule. I instructed staff to call my office rather than my personal phone number, which helped me limit the after-hours work calls I received. I also scheduled later social events or planned weekend activities during busier weeks at the clinic. Once I'd set boundaries, I was more relaxed and felt more satisfied with my job. What's you're applying to work at a clinic that has a certain specialty, such as cardiology, or focuses on a certain type of patient, such as children, then an interviewer may ask if you have experience in that area. You can explain your relevant background and how you gained that experience. If you've worked at general clinics, you can instead tell the interviewer about how your history prepared you to work in that specialty or with that type of patient. Example: "Yes, I worked as the practice manager at a neurology clinic four years ago. I'm confident I can take the skills I learned from working with a team of three neurologists and use them to manage your clinic and your team. I understand some of the unique challenges a neurology practice encounters, particularly with budgeting and managing a large team of nursing assistants and front office staff."3. Describe a time when you helped an employee make an ethical decision or follow regulations. What did you do? Interviewers may ask this question to learn how you overcome ethical challenges at work. Your response can show how you support your employees and encourage them to make decisions that promote health and safety compliance. It can also show how your current team follows rules and legal responsibilities to protect the clinic and its patients. Example: "In a previous position, I noticed a new nurse didn't understand how to follow regulations related to the U.S. Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA). As a result, the nurse gave information about an adult patient to a family member without signed consent. I explained why this was an issue and I instructed the nurse to complete a consent form to prevent the issue from occurring again. After completing the course, the nurse understood HIPAA and helped the rest of the team comply with regulations effectively."
